

Environmental Policy

We are committing to environmental management that protects the environment, prevents pollution and is guided by international good practice principles and in compliance with the regulations of its host countries.

Applicability

This policy applies to all officers, directors, employees and contractors of GoviEx Uranium Inc. ("GoviEx") as well as to each of its subsidiaries or any joint ventures under the company's operational control. It is expected that these parties will adhere to the commitments defined in this policy. This policy also applies, as far as is reasonably achievable, to the GoviEx's service providers, suppliers and third-party contractors.

Commitments

- Complying with applicable environmental law and aligning with relevant industry standards;
- Applying a proactive approach to environmental management, based on defined environmental objectives and closure vision;

- Conserving biodiversity by prioritising impact avoidance and managing unavoidable impacts;
- Addressing climate change mitigation and adaptation in our business strategy and project design;

- Open engagement with stakeholders on our environmental performance and their interests and concerns;
- Assessing, monitoring and auditing our activities to ensure continuous performance improvement;
- Reporting on environmental performance clearly and transparently.
